ELEMENTARY/HIGH SCHOOL BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
COMBINED REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2011

The School Board of Trustees of School District No. 6 met in the district board room on Tuesday, September 13, 2011.

- CALL TO The meeting was called to order at 5:25 pm by Chair June Beartusk.

- CONSENT Headswift moved and Cain seconded to approve the consent agenda (Payroll Warrants, District and Activity Warrants for August 2011 and Minutes for August 9, 2011) as stated. All voted in favor.
- PERSONNEL **Mitchell moved and Headswift seconded to table this item until the August 29, 2011 board meeting. All voted in favor. Hire Eunice Davis, Geneva Glenmore, Cindy Bowen and Ronnette Glenmore for Elementary – Junior High Paraprofessionals for the 2011-12 school year due to the increase in student enrollment. All voted in favor.**

- SRO HIRE Kott spoke on hiring an SRO for 2011-12 school year, according to the Lame Deer Chief of Police this applicant has all of the required paperwork in and is willing to work for the district.
- Scalpcane moved and Cain seconded to hire LeAnn Yellow Hawk as the SRO (School Resource Officer) for the 2011-12 school year. All voted in favor.

Jim Loy spoke to the board regarding the active sports such as Football with gate and concession profit; Volleyball will be played in a JV status due to the low number of students interested and the hiring of the Coaches and Sponsors for the 2011-12 school year.

Mitchell moved and W White Crane seconded to hire the following High School Coaches/Advisors: Byron Woods for Head Cross Country Coach and Head Track Coach Jade Walksalong for Cheerleading Advisor; Joletta Spang for Pep Club Advisor; Ken Sattler for Debate Coach; Jim Loy for Student Council Advisor; Ken Sattler for Sophomore Class Advisor; Bonnie Bigback for Freshman Class Advisor; Alison Legg for Annual Advisor; Ken Sattler for Academic Olympics; Larry Medicine Bull for Indian Week Coordinator/Indian Club Advisor; Deeanna Williams for Mini Bank Advisor; Ethelene Stump for Concessions; Bonnie Bigback for FCCLA Advisor; Peggy Fredericks for National Honor Society Advisor; George Riedel for Outdoor Club Advisor; Deeanna Williams for Math Club Advisor and Byron Woods for Aises Advisor and LaQuinta Fighting Bear for Assistant Volleyball Coach at the prorated rate. All voted in favor with the exception of Cain who abstained.

RN REQST.: Kott explained a letter attached by Anita Small (Registered Nurse) requesting to work part-time which will save the district money when her salary will decrease and insurance will not be paid for her.

Scalpcane moved and Cain seconded to approve of Anita Small's request to work part-time as stated above. All voted in favor.

CLASS.INC. Kott updated the board on this item and how he would like to reimburse our current staff to purchase their CDL's to assist in Driving a Bus due to the shortage in bus drivers this school year.

Scalpcane moved and Cain seconded to approve of reimbursing classified staff that pass their test for a CDL's to assist in the transportation department as bus drivers.

ELE.PRINC. Board Chair recognized Sherry Foote to present her report. She informed the board on her schedules and the increase enrollment at the elementary school. Foote informed the board of hiring Denise Shirley and Michael Comes At Night for Kindergarten and First Grade teachers. She asked for permission from the board to allow the teachers to begin work on 9/14/11. Mitchell moved and Headswift seconded to allow two Elementary teachers to begin work on 9/14/11 and hire them at a later meeting. All voted in favor.

Mitchell moved and Cain seconded to schedule a special meeting on 9/15/11 at 12:00 noon to hire the elementary teachers needed. All voted in favor.

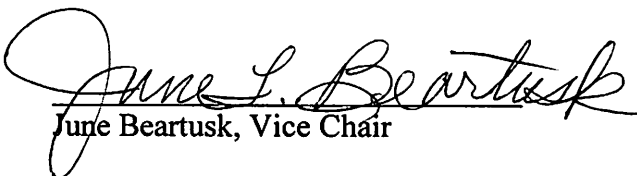
BOARD RPT Other None...

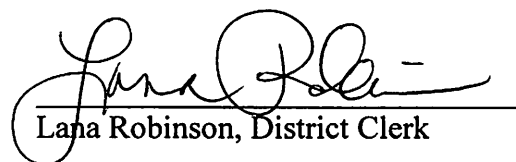
SUPT. RPT. Kott attached the Field Report on the Elementary Construction plus pass the pictures around on the progress of the work.
