ELEMENTARY/HIGH SCHOOL BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
COMBINED SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES  
TUESDAY, JANUARY 24, 2012

The School Board of Trustees of School District No. 6 met in the district board room on Tuesday, January 24, 2012.

CALL TO The meeting was called to order at 12:09 pm by Chairperson June Beartusk.

PRESENT: June Beartusk, Suzette Cain, Rosanne Headswift, Waymon Mitchell, Kim Knobloch, Merrilee Red Robe, George Scalpcane and Winslow White Crane.

ABSENT: Vincent White Crane, Unexcused.

OTHERS Bryan Kott, Lana Robinson, Aundre Bell, Robin Nansel, Byron Woods, Joseph Limberhand.

CONSENT AGENDA Scalpcane moved and Mitchell seconded to approve the consent agenda as is except the December 13, 2011. He requested these minutes be pulled and voted on separately.

Board Chair asked if anyone had anything to say on the consent agenda. Knobloch asked what the beads were for and if the board could see an end project on these. Kott stated they were for the 21<sup>st</sup> century after school program and was sure an end project could be provided. All voted in favor.

MINUTES Headswift moved and Beartusk seconded to approve the December 13, 2011 minutes. All voted in favor with the exception of Scalpcane and Knobloch who opposed. Motion carried.

PERSONNEL HIRE Kott stated due to Pattee Bement (Teacher Sub Hire) being related to a board member there has to be a full board at the meeting to decide on hiring her and all have to vote in favor. This item was tabled until the next school board meeting.

**PERSONNEL COACH HR** Headswift moved and Beartusk seconded to hire Austin Two Moons and Cleveland Bement as Assistant JH Boys Basketball Coaches for the 2011-12 year and Pattee Bement Head Coach and Molly Spang Wilson as Assistant JH Girls Basketball Coaches for the 2012-13 school year. All voted in favor with the exception of Cain who opposed.

**ELEM. PRIN.** Sherry was on training and not available to go over her report.

**JH PRINC. REPORT** Board Chair recognized Aundre Bell for his report. Bell spoke on attendance, activity calendar, discipline referrals, emergency procedure drills with BIA Law Enforcement, staff evaluations schedule, his schedule and spoke on graphs.

Bell also spoke on student attendance stating we need to figure a way to perfect the attendance and stick with the policy on this. He stated when March rolls around for kids to take the test, it's hard for a teacher to teach when there are no students in school. They are trying to work with the Lame Deer Police Department to get students in school. He feels the school needs to raise the bar for each student.

Discussion on attendance issues at school.

**JH AD REP.** Byron Woods was available, he spoke on the JH athletic schedules.

He presented to the board a training that he and Aundre Bell would like to attend to help with future athletics. Headswift moved and Cain seconded to approve Byron Woods and Aundre Bell to attend training in Salt Lake City, Utah for a Bigger Faster and Stronger Clinic on March 10, 2012. All voted in favor.

**O/S TRIP 7<sup>th</sup> GRADE** Byron Woods also presented to the board an out of state trip for his 7<sup>th</sup> grade Science Class for a 3-5 day inquiry based science camp in Yellowstone National Park. He stated the district provide transportation and food for the students.

Kott stated that SIG or 21<sup>st</sup> Century grants may be able to help with this funding.

Cain moved and Mitchell seconded to allow this out of state trip to Yellowstone National Park for 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Science Class and they asked that he fundraise for any extra cost. All voted in favor.

**O/S TRIP 8<sup>th</sup> GRADE** Byron Woods presented to the board another out of state trip for the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Science Class. He was requesting a trip to visit the wilderness center in Helena. They have received a partial grant to cover for transportation and lodging cost.

Kott stated SIG (School Improvement Grant), Title I and 21<sup>st</sup> Century may be able to help with funds for this trip.

Mitchell moved and Cain seconded to approve of this 8<sup>th</sup> grade science trip request provided Byron will fundraise. All voted in favor.

**HS PRINC.** This item was tabled due to time shortage.

POP DISP. This item was tabled due to time shortage.

O/S TRAVEL This item was tabled due to time shortage.

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HS PRINC. Mitchell moved and Red Robe seconded to approve of the SOAR Tutor Hires without a driver's license but encourage them to get their driver's license in the future. All voted in favor.

**AR GYM Joseph Limberhand was available to request use of the AR Gym the weekend of March 16, 17 & 18, 2012 for a Little Cheyenne Head start Fundraiser. The do have liability insurance through the tribe and will provide a copy for this.**

**Mitchell moved and Cain seconded to allow them the use of the AR Gym provided they check the schedule with Judy Ross. All voted in favor.**

**O/D ENROL. Mitchell moved and Cain seconded to approve of the following out of district enrollments for the following students. All voted in favor.**
